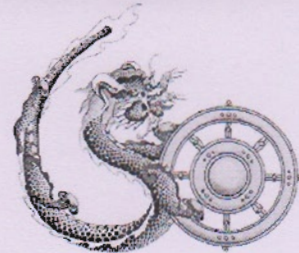

**Celebration of the 60<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo in Sri Lanka**

During his recent visit to Sri Lanka from 15-18 November 2015, Foreign Secretary Tshering Dorji hosted a luncheon for the Bhutanese community in Colombo to commemorate the 60th Birth Anniversary of His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo Jigme Singye Wangchuck.

In addition, Bhutan's Ambassador to Sri Lanka, Aum Pema Choden hosted a dinner for the Bhutanese students of the University of Peradeniya on 14 November 2015.

Foreign Secretary Tshering Dorji also hosted a reception and dinner for the government and university officials and members of Sri Lanka business community on 17 November 2015.

The aforementioned events were organized by the Royal Bhutanese Embassy, Dhaka in addition to the celebrations on 11 November in Bangladesh which included the offer of *tshethar* of 60 kgs of live fish and launching of a booklet published by the Embassy with poems, essays, and art work contributed by Bhutanese students in Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, and South Korea, as tribute to His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo.
