## PRESS RELEASE ROYAL CIVIL SERVICE AWARD 2018

- In keeping with Section 22 of the Bhutan Civil Service Rules and Regulations 2012, Royal Civil Service Medals were awarded to four members of the Permanent Mission of Bhutan in New York following a ceremony conducted on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2018 by H.E. Ambassador Doma Tshering, Permanent Representative of Bhutan to the United Nations in New York.
  - Mr. Chador Wangdi, PS to Kutshab, and Mr. Kinley Dorji, Chauffeur, received medals for over 10 years of dedicated service to the Royal Government.
  - Mr. Aniceto Almazan, Building Superintendent, and Mr. Lunaver Estralla, Chauffeur, were awarded medals for over 30 years of service to the Royal Government.
- The Royal Civil Service Award was instituted by RCSC in 2013 under the Royal Command of His Majesty the King. The Award recognizes dedicated service to the Tsawa Sum, and provides the opportunity to reaffirm commitment and dedication in service to the nation.
