(https://twitter.com/PIBHomeAffairs/status/1238494878637543424) has the honour to draw the attention of the esteemed Ministry to Para 4 of the said OM which states: "Restrictions mentioned in Para-1 above on the Indo-Nepal & Indo-Bhutan Borders shall be applicable only for third country nationals and not to Indian nationals or nationals of Nepal or Bhutan".

The Embassy of India also has the honour to refer to the Advisory issued by the Bureau of Immigration, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India (https://boi.gov.in/content/advisory-travel-and-visa-restrictions-related-covid-19-0) and FAQs (https://boi.gov.in/sites/default/files/u4/faq-covid-19.pdf) dated 13 March 2020. The Embassy would like to draw attention to Sr. no. 4 of Point no. 4 of the FAQs "Title: FOREIGNERS WHO WANT TO COME TO INDIA, Question: Are Nepal, Bhutan and Maldives passport holders allowed?, Answer: Nepal and Bhutan nationals are allowed. Maldives nationals would require visa."
