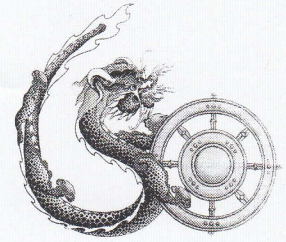

Notification

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs would like to inform the general public that the Immigration and Checkpoint Authority of Singapore have introduced the new BioScreen System from April 2016.

All foreign visitors to Singapore (ages 6 and above), who use the manned immigration counters are required to scan their thumbprints each time they arrive and depart Singapore.

From 1 July 2016, foreign visitors who had successfully enrolled their thumbprints via BioScreen during their arrival at the manned immigration counters will be able to use automated self-clearance when departing Singapore. Accordingly, they will not have their departures endorsed in their passports. Foreign visitors who use manned immigration counters will continue to have their departures endorsed. The automated self-clearance departure facilities will be progressively implemented at Singapore's checkpoints.
